

Generic HVAC PM Checklist



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	Check thermostat settings and operation for accuracy and responsiveness. Inspect and clean air filters; replace if visibly dirty or clogged. Visually inspect ductwork and registers for blockages or damage. Check condensate drain line for clogs or standing water. Inspect electrical connections for corrosion, wear, or overheating.
Qu	arterly Tasks
	Clean evaporator and condenser coils to maintain heat transfer efficiency. Inspect blower assembly: motor, belt tension, and fan blades. Test system controls: start-up, shut-down, and safety interlocks. Check refrigerant levels and pressure; look for leaks or frost buildup. Lubricate moving parts (bearings, motors, dampers) as needed.
Не	at Exchanger-Specific Tasks
	Inspect heat exchanger surfaces for cracks, corrosion, or soot buildup. Perform combustion analysis (gas units) to verify efficiency and safety. Clean heat exchanger fins and tubes using manufacturer-approved tools. Check for carbon monoxide leaks near exchanger and flue outlets. Document exchanger condition and compare against previous inspections.
Sei	mi-Annual Tasks
	Review system performance logs for temperature swings or runtime anomalies. Clean return air grilles and supply vents to improve airflow. Inspect insulation and weather seals around unit and duct penetrations. Test emergency shut-off and reset mechanisms.

0000	chedule professional inspection and servicing of entire HVAC system. eplace worn components: belts, capacitors, contactors, sensors. erform full safety and compliance audit (electrical, fire, ventilation). aspect and certify fire suppression system (if installed near unit).
