Daily Tasks
<ul> <li>Check and log internal temperature using a calibrated thermometer.</li> <li>Inspect door seals and gaskets for cracks, gaps, or frost buildup.</li> <li>Wipe down door handles and high-touch surfaces with food-safe cleaner.</li> <li>Listen for unusual noises from compressor, fans, or evaporator.</li> <li>Ensure airflow is unobstructed by properly spacing stored items.</li> </ul>
Weekly Tasks
<ul> <li>☐ Clean door gaskets with warm water and mild detergent.</li> <li>☐ Check door hinges, latches, and closers for proper alignment.</li> <li>☐ Inspect drain lines and pans for clogs or ice buildup.</li> <li>☐ Verify light fixtures and door alarms are functioning correctly.</li> <li>☐ Organize inventory to prevent overloading and allow air circulation.</li> </ul>
Monthly Tasks
<ul> <li>Clean condenser coils with a soft brush or vacuum (power off first).</li> <li>Inspect evaporator coils for frost or ice accumulation.</li> <li>Check fan motors and blades for wear, dust, or vibration.</li> <li>Calibrate thermostat and defrost timers for accuracy.</li> <li>Clean behind and underneath unit to remove debris and dust.</li> </ul>
Quarterly Tasks
<ul> <li>Test defrost cycle for proper operation and timing.</li> <li>Review temperature logs for trends or anomalies.</li> <li>Conduct staff refresher training on freezer safety and loading practices.</li> <li>Inspect insulation panels and vapor barriers for damage or moisture intrusion.</li> </ul>

## **Annual Tasks**

Schedule professional inspection and servicing of refrigeration system.
Replace worn components: gaskets, fan motors, thermostats, door closers.
Perform full safety and compliance audit (electrical, food safety, ventilation).
Inspect and certify fire suppression system (if installed nearby).
Evaluate energy efficiency and consider upgrades or retrofits
