

Generic Exhaust Fan PM Checklist



Monthly Tasks

 Inspect fan blades and housing for debris, corrosion, or damage. Check motor operation for unusual noise, vibration, or overheating. Clean fan blades and shroud to maintain airflow and balance. Inspect electrical connections for wear, corrosion, or loose terminals. Verify fan speed and airflow output against baseline performance. 	
Quarterly Tasks	
 Clean and inspect grease traps or collection trays (especially in kitchen exhaust system Check belt tension and alignment (for belt-driven units); adjust or replace as needed. Inspect weatherproof seals and flashing around fan base for leaks or deterioration. Lubricate bearings and moving parts per manufacturer guidelines. Test backdraft damper operation to ensure proper airflow control. 	ıs).
Semi-Annual Tasks	
 Review airflow and ventilation logs for performance anomalies. Clean rooftop area around fan to prevent debris accumulation and airflow obstruction. Inspect fan mounting hardware and brackets for rust or looseness. Check motor amperage draw and compare to rated specs. 	

Annual Tasks

	Schedule professional inspection and servicing of motor, bearings, and electrical system.
	Replace worn components: belts, bearings, gaskets, vibration isolators.
\bigcap	Perform full safety and compliance audit (electrical, fire, ventilation).
